

Parents and students,

There have been some concerns expressed about grades and assignments since March 13th. We are continuing with school and will do so until May 15th. Below are the guidelines given to teachers for work assigned after March 13, 2020.

The GMAS Study Guides are the required work for the weeks prior to Spring Break (March 16 - April 3). These may be assigned a grade by teachers. All other work, prior to Spring Break, can be used to replace low grades or to demonstrate mastery of standards that students had not mastered prior to March 13th; however, students will not be penalized for this work.

Beginning today (April 13th), every grade level/class began assigning required assignments. These assignments are for new grades. Grade levels/classes may also assign enrichment assignments which are optional and should be labeled as optional or enrichment. These can be used to replace low grades or to demonstrate mastery. We will continue to have new required assignments each week for the next five weeks.

If students are completing and submitting the assignments digitally, that is all they need to do. The GMAS packets and any other assignments completed on paper may be turned in to the bins which have been placed in front of Gray Elementary School and beside the bus ramp at Clifton Ridge Middle School. There is a bin for each school. Please be sure to label assignments with the student's name, grade, and teacher's name. Assignments will be accepted at these two locations until May 19th.
