





All things SENIOR for the Class of 2022



Senior Grad Walk

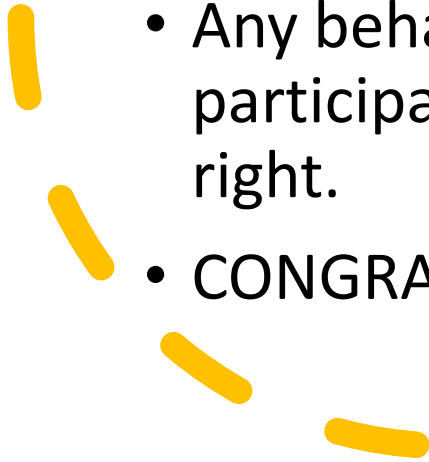
- 
- Grad walk is for the students only – parents are not allowed to attend
 - We will visit each school in the county. We will unload buses, walk through the hallways that will be lined with teachers/students and walk out of the other end. We keep the line moving!
 - After we exit each building - students who attended that school will gather in the front for a picture
 - You will ride the same bus all day – so know your bus number and know your seat buddy.
 - We will return to the high school at lunch time. We will do a large group picture at the high school and then lunch will be provided for you.

Graduation Practice

- Monday – May 23rd
- Graduation practice is MANDATORY – you will NOT walk if you do not attend
- Riding the bus to practice is MANDATORY – you cannot drive and meet us there
- You must be at JCHS in the auditorium (in dress code) by 7:45am
- We will meet with you – talk with you – and load buses to ride to the Centennial Center
- You will not be able to load buses to go to practice without ALL of your fees having been paid. Be sure you have paid any fees to Mrs. Kilgore or any media fees to Mrs. Dockery



- At the Centennial Center you will be put in order, and we will practice the ceremony.
- The more you pay attention and listen and do right – the faster we will get done and get back
- Your names will be called as they will at graduation during practice. Please listen to it carefully and let us know any pronunciation issues that you hear so that we can correct it.
- We should return to school by lunchtime, and at that point, you are dismissed to go about your day.
- Any behavioral issues at practice can result in the inability to participate in the graduation ceremony. The ceremony is a privilege, not a right.
