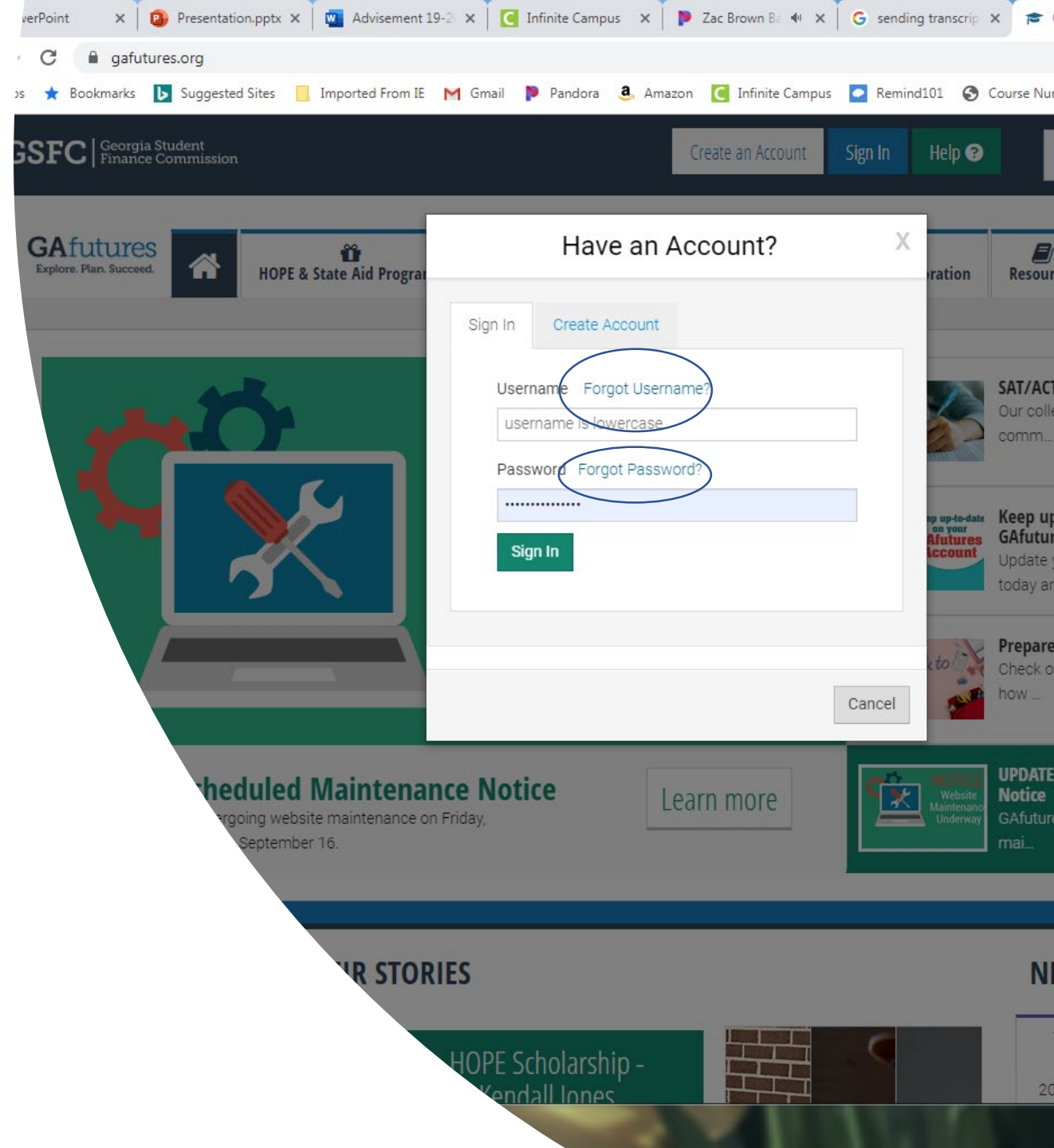

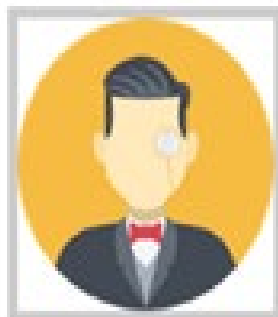
GAFutures.org

- EVERYONE needs a gafutures account. You will use it in high school as well as in college. Many of you have already created one. If you cannot remember your username/password, use the "forgot my _____" link on the login page.
- Last resort – create an entirely new account
- You do NOT have to enter your GTID Number
- Social Security and Date of Birth must be entered and must be accurate if you want to see HOPE GPA or send your transcripts, etc.
- You also use gafutures to do your funding apps for Dual Enrollment

In-State Transcripts

- If you are applying to a college in the state of Georgia – **you** will request for your transcript to be sent at the time of applying to the school(s) AND again for your final transcript at the end of the school year.

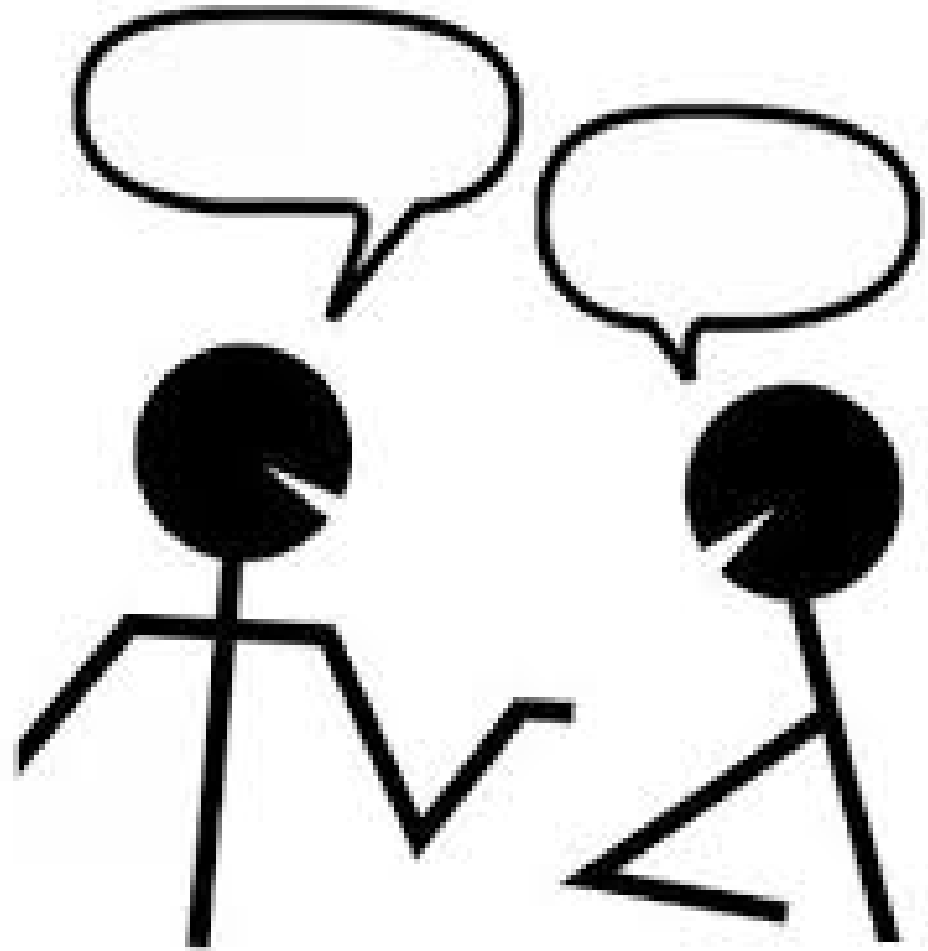
High School Students

College students receiving HOPE/Zell Miller Funds

- You want to send transcripts to colleges AFTER you have completed the application
- If the college is in the state of Georgia – request your transcript through gafutures.org

Out of State Transcripts

- These have to be mailed
- Come tell Mrs. Pittman where you need your transcript sent
- Be sure you have already submitted the application!



FINAL Transcript

In May, once you have been accepted and chosen your college of choice, you will need to send your FINAL transcript to that college.

You'll need to follow these same steps to send your FINAL transcript.

Other Transcripts

If doing Dual Enrollment, you will also need to request a transcript from the college(s) you are taking classes with and have that sent to your future college you have applied to.

You can do this through your student portal for most colleges, or you can contact the college Registrar. There will be a fee, usually \$5, for each one you send.

You will need to do this again at the end of the year for the FINAL transcript.

Your college you are going to in the fall will need BOTH the High School AND the College Transcript(s)!
